Courts to stay open as prosecutors meet

KAMPALA-23 June 2017: The Judiciary has received a communication from the Office of the Director of Public Prosecution (DPP) that all state prosecutors/ state attorneys will be away today – 23rd June 2017.

According to the communication, the DPP staff will be attending a Uganda Association of Prosecutors' extraordinary meeting, so they will be unable to attend court.

In the circumstances, the Judiciary guides as follows:

1. All courts are to stay open to conduct normal court operations.
2. Judges and magistrates handling criminal matters, where the state attorneys/ prosecutors are involved, shall appropriately adjourn the cases to the next convenient dates.
3. The Courts shall continue receiving, registering all cases normally and hearing civil and criminal matters, until state attorneys/prosecutors are available for court business.

The Judiciary is committed to administering Justice to all in an independent, timely and affordable manner.
