### **We do not condone misuse of government vehicles - Judiciary**

**KAMPALA:** The attention of the Judiciary is drawn to media reports of a vehicle, registration number UG 0501J, found in a foiled suspected robbery incident in Iganga town on 22 October 2018.

We wish to confirm that the said vehicle is indeed part of the Judiciary fleet and we regret the incident. It is however, important to note that the person who had the vehicle at the time of the incident, was not authorised to drive it.

We are reliably informed that the Police in Iganga has opened investigations into the incident. The Judiciary is equally eager to establish the circumstances under which its vehicle ended up in Iganga.

Please note that the Judiciary strictly observes the provisions of the Uganda Public Service Standing Orders relating to the Use and Care of Government Vehicles. We do not condone any kind of misuse of official vehicles by any of the public officers.
