That upon further follow-up on my matter despite the fact my tenure was still subsisting and also in line with the Labour Disputes (Arbitration and Settlement) Act, though I had earlier got information of the purported nominations by the NOTU Executive Board of new Panelists to the Industrial Court</p> <p>5. That thereafter the said purported nominations of panelists by NOTU, the said names were forwarded to the Minister of Gender, Labour &amp; Social Development for which she appointed other panelists who have been working since then and now for over Five Months and have been engaging the immediate concerned offices like the Office of the Hon.
